A 4‰ consortium for an inclusive and efficient governance

A light structure, with no legal personality ⇒
The consortium « 4 per 1000 »
soils for food security and climate

A declaration of intention to create and outline the consortium

Four bodies

Consultation & collaboration body	⇒	Forum of the partners of the initiative
Decision - making body	⇒	Meeting of the members of the consortium
Scientific body	⇒	Scientific and technical committee
Executive body	\Rightarrow	Secrétariat

Meeting of the members of the consortium

Decision-making body

Decisions on orientations, work plan, budget, reference document, etc.

Decisions to be taken on the basis of consensus.

<u>Members:</u> any non profit and non commercial organisation signatory of the declaration of intention creating the consortium

Meetings: At least one annual meeting at the same time of the Forum meeting + ad-hoc meeting if necessary

Forum of the partners of the initiative

- Consultative body
- Building of partnerships and collaborations
- Made up of 5 colleges:
 - States, international/regional organisations, development banks
 - Research and training institutions
 - Agricultural producers organisations
 - Civil society organisations and non profit foundations
 - Commercial or for profit companies
- <u>Members:</u> any organisation sharing the principles and objectives of the Initiative.
- Meetings: At least 1 annual meeting + digital community



















Scientific and technical committee

Scientific body

- Issues opinions, advices, propositions
- Provides scientific and technical support
- Provides the scientific background

Members: 14 internationally recognised scientists, chosen by the consortium (proposal by the secretariat). Pluridisciplinary group with a balanced composition from different regions of the world and gender balance

International secretariat

- Executive body
- Executes decisions and facilitates the operation of the initiative
- Supports the Consortium, the STC, the Forum and the members
- 3 4 people under the authority of an executive secretary :
 - STC secretariat links with the research programme
 - Facilitation follow-up support to projects
 - Communication
- Human and financial resources provided by voluntary members.
- Temporarily hosted in France

Next steps towards COP 22

Setting up of the governance:

28 April 2016: Draft governance framework presented in Meknes 28 April – 15 June: Consultation on the draft declaration of intention 30 June 2016: Final version of the declaration of intention open for signature

From July 2016 on: creation of the consortium:

- Setting up of the secretariat
- Selection of members of the STC by members of the consortium

⇒ 7 – 18 November 2016 : First meeting of the Forum of partners during COP 22 in Marrakesh

Launching work ⇒ 2016 Roadmap

Preparation of reference criteria for project evaluation:

→ Objective : proposition of reference document by STC during COP 22

Mise en place du programme de recherche et de coopération scientifique

Implementation of the research and scientific cooperation programme

→ Objective : setting-up of project governance and funding for COP 22

Deployment of the digital expertise centre : web-based collaborative platform and resources centre

→ Objective : progressive implementation from September - October

2017 - 2018 roadmap

→ Objective : preparation in September – October, adoption during COP
 22 in Marrakech
